

Announcing GAOC Junior Travel Grant Program



The GAOC Junior Travel Grant Program offers high school and middle school kids three grant options they may use for individual or team travel to out-of-state A-Meets.

Why go out of state when you're having so much fun in GA? Well besides gaining competitive experience on different terrain, meeting kids from different regions, and seeing different parts of the country, you'll receive national USOF Rankings when you compete in 2 A-Meets during the year.

Are you interested? Check out these options:

- Individual Travel Grants of \$50 are available to help families offset the cost of sending their kids to out-of-Georgia A-meets. There's a limit of 2 individual grants per family and one individual grant per child in a calendar year.
- School Team Grants of \$200 are available to help schools offset the cost of sending their teams to out-of-Georgia A-meets. There's a limit of 2 team grants per school in a calendar year.
- International Travel Grants of \$500 are available to help the exceptional kids who have been named by USOF to one of the USOF Junior Teams for International competition, such as JWOC. There's a limit of one international grant to a kid in a calendar year.
