5. For JROTC teams: Are enrolled in the same JROTC unit per the most current Unit Enrollment Report.
6. All team members are USOF members in good standing.
7. All team members are U.S. citizens -or- hold permanent resident ("green card") status -or- hold dual U.S. citizenship and reside primarily in the United States.
